

A joint venture between Anel Group of Turkey and Enerqos SPA of Italy will install a photovoltaic plant with EU commission funds in Turkish Cyprus.

The plant will be the first and the largest one in Cyprus and in the Mediterranean area.

Milan, 3 December 2009 - The EU tendering commission awarded the joint venture between Anel Group and Enerqos spa of the construction of 1,3 MW photovoltaic (PV) plant in the Turkish part of Cyprus, after the invitation for tenders announced in June this year. Anel Group and Enerqos' joint venture won the tender submitting the best financial offer and proving the best technical skills in system integration and construction of large scale PV plants.

The plant, which will represent the first PV installation in Cyprus and the biggest in the whole Mediterranean area, will be fully financed by EU Commission. Construction works will start in January 2010.

The solar system, which will be donated to Kib-tek (Cyprus Turkish Electric Corporation), will produce 2 GWh of clean energy annually and contribute to eliminate the power cuts experienced on the Cyprus island during summer, due to over demand for energy.

"This initiative represents a further step of our international growth process" declares Mauro Marcucci, CEO of Enerqos spa, "We are glad to enhance our presence in the Mediterranean area, the most promising area for solar industry, with a strong and reliable partner such as Anel Group".

"This plant is the expression of the great potential of the Mediterranean region in the renewable sector" explains Ender Çolak, vice chairman of Anel Group "We are convinced that Turkey, together with Greece and the whole Mediterranean area, will shortly become the new leaders in the solar energy field. This first project will lead to many other interesting activities in joint-venture with Enerqos spa in the very next months".
